

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

OF

HOAGS CORNERS VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE ASSOCIATION, INC.

Pursuant to the Membership Corporations Law.

We, the undersigned, for the purpose of forming a membership corporation pursuant to the Membership Corporation Law of the State of New York, hereby certify:

1. The name of the proposed corporation shall be HOAGS CORNERS VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE ASSOCIATION, INC.

2. The purposes for which it is to be formed are:

(a) To voluntarily cause to be rendered first aid assistance to persons injured in accidents and to voluntarily render all necessary assistance and services to persons and property in case of public calamity, accidents, and/or emergencies.

(b) To convey and transport sick or injured persons to places where medical aid or assistance can be administered.

3. The territory in which its operations are principally to be conducted is the Town of Nassau, Rensselaer County, New York, and the territory adjacent thereto within a radius of ten miles of the boundaries thereof.

4. The principal office of said Corporation shall be in the Hamlet of Hoags Corners, Town of Nassau, Rensselaer County, New York.
